- Check water connection for leaks.
- Check drain connection for clogs.

### **STOVE:** average life

- expectancy = 20 years
- Check oven door for broken glass.
- Check for gas leaks.

# INGREDIENTS FOR SAFETY

#### LEARN SOME BASIC HOLIDAY FOOD PREPARATION SAFETY TIPS BEFORE YOU START COOKING.

- Never leave cooking equipment unattended. Turn off burners if you have to leave the room or have someone else take over.
- Clean the stovetop and oven of grease and dust.
- Keep the cooking area around the stove/ oven clear of combustibles, such as towels, napkins and pot holders.
- Wear short or close-fitting sleeves to avoid catching clothing on fire.
- Use the back burners and turn the pot handles in, away from reaching hands to protect from spills and burns.
- Locate all appliances away from the sink.
- Plug countertop appliances into ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI)-protected outlets.
- Keep appliance cords away from hot surfaces like the range or toaster.
- Turn off and unplug all appliances when cooking is complete.

## I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day

A holiday wish for a peaceful and happy holiday

ach year, the Christmas season offers a reminder of our common humanity. And in 2020, do we ever need it.

I heard the bells on Christmas Day Their old, familiar carols play, And wild and sweet The words repeat Of peace on earth, good-will to men!

Longfellow writes how the thundering cannons of war drowned out the carols which sing "of peace on earth, good-will to men."

And in despair I bowed my head; "There is no peace on earth," I said: "For hate is strong, And mocks the song Of peace on earth, good-will to men!"

Then pealed the bells more loud and deep "God is not dead; nor doth he sleep!

The Wrong shall fail The Right prevail, With peace on earth, good-will to men!"

In 1872, John Baptiste Calkin set Longfellow's poem to music, a Christmas carol that still resounds.

In that spirit of resilience and hope, all of us at Inter-County Energy wish you a peaceful and happy holiday season.
